Dear Sisters and Brothers,

As the nation observes Black History Month throughout February, it reminds me to express gratitude to my Black colleagues and friends for all I have learned from them and the support we have shared with each other. There is a wonderful African term: *Ubuntu*, which translates roughly into: "I am who I am because of who you are to me." Among others, I learned from Archbishop Desmond Tutu that a person who is practicing *Ubuntu* is "open and available to others, also operating with a proper sense of self-assurance."

To offer a summary of how African Americans have contributed to the shaping of the Church, I appreciate the history supplied on the PC(USA) Website: *To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good.*—1 Cor. 12:7 Should Presbyterians spend time reading and learning about the roles that African Americans have played in the foundation of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.)? Much of our Church offers a resounding, "Yes!" of course African American Presbyterian history matters!

Like the ministry of John Gloucester, for example. In 1807, Gloucester arrived in Philadelphia and began preaching. Rising from slavery and oppression, he formed the first African American Presbyterian congregation in 1811 and led African American Presbyterians to see the light of Christ within each of them. He was the first ordained African American minister in the Presbyterian Church. African American women have played a major role in shaping education throughout the years. Lucy Craft Laney, who organized a school in the basement of Christ Presbyterian Church in Augusta, Ga., was a recipient of the General Assembly Women of Faith Award.

This month is a time that the church and the nation have set aside to honor African Americans, who have contributed so much to society and the church. We celebrate the history and contributions of African Americans in the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) now and throughout the year. And we continue to be inspired by those who have ensured that equal opportunities are offered to all people, regardless of the color of their skin.

Truly, John and Lucy provide just a couple of highlights of very noteworthy pilgrims on a rigorous journey of faith. I celebrate their devotion, courage, and commitment to sharing God's love. One does not have to be a MLK, Jr. or a Rosa Parks to practice *Ubuntu*. We are all made stronger, as we share our gifts, dreams, and manifestations of the Holy Spirit.
