Dear Friends,

In Seasons of Celebration, Thomas Merton wrote: But now the power of Easter has burst upon us with the resurrection of Christ. Now we find in ourselves a strength which is not our own, and which is freely given to us whenever we need it, raising us above the Law, giving us a new law which is hidden in Christ: the law of his merciful love for us. Now we no longer strive to be good because we have to, because it is a duty, but because our joy is to please him who has given all his love to us! Now our life is full of meaning!

My heart is still soaring with Easter Resurrection Joy! The Choir's powerful Cantata proclaiming the story "Let's Sing To the Risen King," the Children's spirited addition of "Our God is an Awesome God," the exuberance of the Worshiping Congregation, and the spectacular sunshine all came together for a most majestic day! Around 60 people even gathered for Sunrise (7:30am) and Breakfast! Thank you, Men of the Church for the delicious hot meal!

Whether you were here to experience - or heard about the Benediction Celebration -you might appreciation an explanation. I learned in a previous congregation about a vigorous Puerto Rican Easter Tradition.





When the congregation declares: "Christ is Risen, Christ is Risen, Indeed!" all the people present pair up and break open an egg on each other's head. The eggs have been previously blown out, dyed, had confetti inserted, and the small opening covered with colored tissue paper. When friends declare "INDEED!" they are invited to burst these eggs on each other's heads! It is supposed to symbolize a burst of new life, a fresh new beginning, a joyful surprise! After Christmas, my dear husband started blowing out eggs. He gave me nine dozen empty egg shells five weeks ago. "Bless his heart!" I have celebrated this Puerto Rican Tradition with 24 and 36 eggs, but never 108! I so appreciate the joy you shared, and your sense of surprise.

MUCH MORE than a colorful burst of joy, the love and mercy we receive from our Lord is no longer hidden. Our striving to serve Him need no longer be from a sense of obligation, duty, or dread of penalty when we make a mistake. We DO need a strength beyond our own, but one that is grounded in the love of Jesus Christ. Thanks be to God when our lives are full of that meaning.
