Dear Friends,

When I need to be productive, but feel foggy and out of sorts, I turn to one of my favorite sources of meditation. Often, it's the 23rd Psalm, reflective prayer to unravel the knots of the day, or maybe even a walk for fresh air and some inspiring scenery. But it's dark, I'm empty, and I'm tired. Sr. Joyce Rupp is one of my favorite authors. She opens her essay on "Seeking and Finding" with Jeremiah 29:13: "When you search for me, you will find me; when you search wholeheartedly for me, I shall let you find me."

Then she acknowledges our human tendency. "We may not be consciously aware of our seeking. We may just be living our lives day by day. The wonder is that while this searching goes on within us, there is also One who keeps seeking us out, calling to us, greatly desiring that we find the home within."

We are living in this rich season between the proclamation of the Easter Resurrection of One in anticipation of the birth of the Church for All, on Pentecost Sunday. Yet while we long to spread this Good News to others, we are still searching for that validation for ourselves and for our church. With some of the questions, challenges, and disappointments around us, we struggle to get from a place of scarcity into the realm of God's abundant love. The hope revolves around finding the balance of exerting the energy to pursue a deeper relationship, and resting in the arms of the One who loves us through the storms and into the sunrise.

Rupp's Closing Prayer strengthens me. "God of all seekers, bless our yearnings for You. Fill us with courage to do what is best for the healing of our own hearts and the heart of the world. Accept our gratitude for the many times You have sought us and have invited us to recognize You in the heart of our true self. Amen."
