Dear Friends,

My long held desire to visit someplace, any place in Africa, is on the horizon! I have developed various fascinating relationships with people in ministry from South Africa, Uganda, Liberia, Ghana, and Kenya. I have been repeatedly overwhelmed by the love, trust, and witness of these deeply devoted people as they serve God, even through challenging and sometimes life threatening circumstances.

Before I came to Cook's Memorial, I felt attracted to the many Mission projects this church supports. Naturally, I was also attracted to your connection with the Kajiado Children's Home. The timing feels right for me to be one of the very excited nine people who will fly to Nairobi, travel on to Kajiado, and spend ten days in an amazing immersion experience. Others of you have good memories of walking this journey, so you can visualize much of what we will see and do. Yes, please share your advice!

What I know now is that we will work in pairs to lead devotions over three evenings. The children engage in devotions every night! The theme for this year's Mission will build on *Education in Kenya: Lighting the Fire - "The unfolding of Your words gives light*" (Psalms 119:130). We will worship, enjoy enriching fellowship around food and conversation, and receive increased inspiration from the children who are eager to learn, share, and dance with an enlivening spirit. Our group will even take a Safari adventure at the end of the trip!

We leave on June 20th and return on the 30th. Sherri Cook and Reggie Kimray from the Gideon's International will lead worship on June 23rd. Dan Griggs will preach on the 30th. This gives me a great feeling of confidence that worship will be wonderful at Cook's Memorial too! To help those of us going to Kajiado, and to keep us all feeling connected while we are away, there will be a Commissioning Service with representatives of the Mission Group during worship on June 16th. I know those of you who foster children at KCH are gathering letters, photos, and gifts for us to deliver to your children/Youth. It will be a privilege to serve as your emissaries of prayer, hope, and encouragement.

Thank you all, at Cook's and beyond, for your very illustrated faith and heart felt prayers. Expect to hear some great stories upon our return!
