David's phrase from the 23rd Psalm. The Hebrew word for path is *derekh*, which is keenly stronger than to stroll leisurely along a meandering road. Everyone who is alive and conscious is "on the road," and every day presents us with choices about how we will walk down that road.

"Most of us instinctively want to live life to the fullest, and we make choices that we believe will satisfy our profound hunger for life. Even choices which appear to be self-serving are often made with the hidden hope that we will find satisfaction in some way," as John Parsons reflects. Parsons was a dedicated student of Hebrew language whose mission was to help Talmudic readings grow more relevant for Christians.

As we transition into August, and remember how faithfully your PNC is working to present a Candidate for your New Pastor, how focused your leaders are for presenting a new program year in worship, outreach and fellowship, and how connected you are in care for one another, I wonder how the entire congregation might come together to learn more about the path God is leading Cook's Memorial to take, and how you will support one another in that learning. Sadly, I remember an effort in a previous congregation to engage everyone in conversations about what Christ was leading them to do. There were two Elders who dutifully arrived, one with a grandson, and one who walked in claiming exhaustion from all the work he had done that week. They made their way to the coffee pot and sat down together to enjoy the steaming brew. I invited them to come join the circle conducting a Bible Study on the Book of Acts, talking about the struggles and accomplishments of the early church. Serving on the Session, these two had been exposed to the hope that this study would provide reflection, stimulate ideas, and unite the people around what they wanted for the church's future. The grandfather replied: "Oh, I grew up Baptist, I already know all that stuff" and they declined to join.

John Parsons may have been talking about an individual's walking "on the road." I believe it extends to a way the Body of Christ pursues the journey, too. Summer represents a time of different schedules, fulfilling family commitments, and hopefully, getting some time for rest. August certainly does not imply there is only one month left to finish all those obligations. I trust you have August 25 marked for *Homecoming Sunday* when a whole host of Cook's Memorial family and friends will worship, eat, and enjoy fellowship. Please embrace any opportunity you have for study, fellowship, or continued discipleship as we walk the path of Jesus, for His name's sake.


