# BRIEF BIOS FOR ELDER-ELECTS, CLASS OF 2021 and 2022

Byron Beach: Bryon grew up in Charlotte. His father, Glenn McClain Beach, passed away in 2000, and his mother, Anne Rodgers Beach, is a retired Presbyterian minister and now lives in Mint Hill. He has one sister, Melody Beach, that lives off Albemarle Rd. Byron graduated from South Mecklenburg High School in 1989 and has worked at Menzies Fueling Group at Charlotte Douglas Airport for the last thirty years. He is single and lives on Sunset Road. Byron found his church home with Cook's for the last 10 years and has served on the sound system team, ushering, and assisted with other Worship Ministry duties. Bryon is dedicated to be a regular servant to serve and help out for the church of the Lord.

**F.D. Hager**: F.D. was married in Cook's Church to Pat fifty-nine years ago. They have three children, seven grandchildren, two great-grandchildren and another one due in January. He has been attending Cook's Church for 77 years and has had the honor to serve as an Elder, Deacon, Sunday School teacher, Youth Leader, Senior Adult Leader, and on many committees. He has also served as the President of Cook's Men's Group, President of Mecklenburg Presbytery Men and President Senate of NC Presbytery Men. 
