
Cook's Church Weekly E-News

immediately think, "I'll never make it." Well, you and I both know that's a bit of a dodge, right? You can make it, I assure you especially when you consider you'll be joined by the Holy Spirit as you do so. So, what if you removed all pressure from completing it in a day, a week or a month and instead took a more relaxed approach? You can absolutely do that! In fact, the Bible can very easily be broken down into 365, 2500-word readings (approximate). The average reading speed in America is around 200 words per minute. At that pace, you'll read the entirety of God's Word in the course of the calendar year, committing only 13 minutes per day in doing so. Personally, I favor the Navigator's One-Year Reading plan as it mixes Old and New with the Psalms to give you a bit of each on a daily basis. Starting with this week's newsletter, I'll be putting in the readings each week to keep us all moving towards our goal. May God be with you in your pursuit of His Holy Word!



Church's <u>'Confirmation</u> <u>Program'</u>


