

To begin with, we all must recognize that we're in a precarious position presently as it relates to our future. We have seen dwindling interest, low visitor numbers and even fewer repeat visits. This has led to a reduction in our operating budget which continues to decline in the face of reduced members and inflation. As we're all painfully aware, the pews are far less filled with people than

Cook's Church. Unless we take measured and direct action, it is likely that Cook's will succumb to a variety of societal forces in the coming decade. If you are challenged by this awareness, I wholeheartedly encourage you to come and speak with myself and the Elders of our church. So, assuming we can all agree that numerical growth is necessary for our long-term survival, you'll understand the need we have to take action. Simply put, we must to design a service that is MORE attractive to younger families than ours presently is. We know ours isn't terribly appealing based on a number of factors (divergence in style from growing churches, younger families left and none seem to visit, Playschool parents don't visit, etc.) so we simply must alter things. Our present thinking is that by shortening the length of the service slightly, that we will represent a benefit to young families. In order to accomplish this, we will be taking the following actions - we will reduce congregational singing to one hymn and the concluding song. We will remove the Creedal Affirmation and we will change the timing of the passing of the peace until the end of the service. We will aim to complete the corporate worship component by 10:45am. With the remaining time, members and visitors will be encouraged to either: pass the peace, come to Room 113 to ask questions about the sermon or head to the library for prayer with one of our Elders or Deacons. These changes will occur NEXT SUNDAY (February 18). The idea is to provide a fully spiritually satisfying worship with an added bonus of time flexibility. These changes have


