
### Cook's Church Weekly E-News

Psalm 119:105: "Your Word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path."

Deepening your prayer life through Scripture is a transformative practice that can bring a sense of focus and purpose to your conversations with God. When we pray with Scripture, we allow God's Word to guide us, giving us the language and themes for our prayers. This can help keep our minds from wandering and deepen our connection with God. For example, using a passage like Psalm 23 can lead us to pray for God's guidance and peace, making the words come alive in

our personal circumstances. One method is to choose a Scripture passage each day and meditate on it as you pray. Reflect on what God is revealing to you through the text and ask Him to show you how to live out those truths in your life. Praying through passages like the Lord's Prayer, the Beatitudes, or the Psalms can enrich your prayer time and allow you to engage with God's Word more intimately. The more you incorporate Scripture into your prayers, the more aligned your thoughts and desires become with God's will. It helps you to move beyond simply asking for things, focusing instead on God's character, His promises, and the depth of His relationship with you. As you commit to this practice, you'll find that Scripture not only informs your prayers but also deepens your understanding of God's heart and His plans for your life. Try it this week to see just how quickly life can change as you pour more of your life and energy into your relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ. 


kite/Etch-a-Sketch, bead jewelry/kit, compass, baseball/mitt.




