

As you light each candle on the Advent wreath, let it remind you to pray for peace—not only in your own life but also in the lives of those around you. Pray for relationships that need healing, for the weary and the hurting, and for peace in our world. May this Advent season be one where the Prince of Peace reigns in your heart and life, transforming your worries into worship and your fears into faith. Let's prepare our hearts for the coming of Christ by embracing the gift of peace through prayer. In doing so, we reflect the love and light of Jesus in a world that desperately needs His peace. 


