
Cook's Church Weekly E-News

need of food in our area!


- * We installed new equipment to enhance the streaming quality of our services to accommodate our members and neighbors who are homebound.
- * We welcomed 7 Youth members through Confirmation and 5 Adult members.
- * We added a new Staff Member: Alyssa Overcash.
- * We re-designed the role of Secretary/Administrative Assistant and added the role of Director of Community Engagement. Alyssa will assume both roles.
- * We completed our new Digital Sign.
- * Several trees, all hazards, were either trimmed or taken down.
- * Our Prayer room was created for reflection, prayer and guidance immediately after the morning worship service.
- * We have had needed work done to certain plumbing systems and the boiler.
- * Multiple music programs were held at Cook's and will become a staple for our congregation and the surrounding area.
- * Our Social Media presence has been enhanced and increased.
- The sale of the adjacent 7.9 acres was approved and negotiations are now underway with a quality developer.
- * Because of the property sale a group is being brought together to make plans for the use of the funds from the sale. Picture this as a VISION 2.0 group. Initial thoughts are: 1) Identifying the physical repairs for our aged campus that have long been put aside for lack of funds. 2) Planning with our Financial Advisor for the long-term investment of the funds. This will offer a great deal of financial stability for a very long time. **Please note that we are




